

INYATI GAME LODGE: SELF DRIVE DIRECTIONS

Inyati Game Lodge's precise location may not be accurately represented on Google Maps. To reach our lodge, please use the NEWINGTON GATE entrance.

HERE ARE SOME ESSENTIAL DETAILS:

- Entrance to the Sabi Sand Nature Reserve requires a fee of 2024: ZAR 150 per person/ 2025: ZAR 160 per person, payable at the gate. Self-drive visitors must also pay 2024: ZAR 330 per vehicle / 2025: ZAR 160 per vehicle entrance fee.
- Please retain your entrance receipt as proof and ensure it is stamped at our lodge reception upon departure, serving as your **Exit Permit**.
- Gate opening hours are from 05h00 to 22h00, but be aware that these hours may be subject to change. These restrictions are in place to protect the reserve's natural habitat and wildlife.

To reach Inyati Game Lodge, head towards HAZYVIEW town. Turn off your GPS or SatNav devices and follow these directions carefully.

DIRECTIONS TO INYATI GAME LODGE FROM HAZYVIEW: (± 66 KM)

- 1. Once in Hazyview town, at the second set of traffic lights, turn right onto the R536 (Portia Shabangu), heading towards the Paul Kruger Gate.
- 2. Approximately 35km along this road, look out for signs indicating the Newington Gate / Sabi Sands and "Huntington, Lilydale and Justicia" on the left-hand side of the road. This turn-off is directly opposite the Main Gate Entrance to Elephant Point.
- 3. Newington Gate accesses the Sabi Sands Reserve, where Inyati Game Lodge is located so please follow these signs.
- 4. Turn left and follow this tar road for \pm 9 km.
- 5. You will come to a 4-way crossing and turn right onto a gravel road. (Please note that there is a taxi rank at this 4-way crossing. There are also NO Stop signs. When you turn right onto the gravel road, the taxi rank will be on your left-hand side. If you miss the 4-way stop and reach the Viva Garage on your right-hand side, you have gone too far; you must turn around and return to the 4-way stop.
- 6. After about 1.8 km, a small sign will indicate **Newington Gate**. There is also a sign on the right that says Happy Homes. Turn left here.

7. Continue this road to Newington Gate. You will be required to pay an entrance fee at the gate. As you approach the Lodge, please be aware that you are in a wilderness area where predators and highprofile game roam freely. Do not leave your car for any reason.

RECOMMENDED ROUTE FROM JOHANNESBURG:


Please note that the drive will take approximately $5\frac{1}{2}$ / 6 hours (± 550km)

1. From Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport, take the **R21** toward Boksburg / East Rand. Then, take the **N12** towards eMalahleni (Witbank). This road becomes the **N4** toll road to Nelspruit.



- 2. Follow the N4 highway past Middleburg (Toll Plaza), eMakhazeni (Belfast), and Machadodorp (Toll Plaza). Then, follow the Schoemanskloof option on the N4 towards Nelspruit / **Mbombela**.
- 3. Head east on N4 Nelspruit Northern Bypass. Slight left 270m, then turn right toward R37. Go through one roundabout (1.1 km). At the roundabout, take the first exit onto R37 (800m).
- 4. Turn left onto Madiba Street 1.9 km and continue onto Provincial P9/2 Rd/R40; continue to follow the R40.
- Enter White River, along Chief Mgiyeni Khumalo Drive; at the traffic light (Express Stores on your right), turn left onto Theo Kleynhans Street (sign White River Country Estates) green sign - R40 Hazyview /R538 Numbi Gate and continue to follow R40 Hazyview. At the roundabout, follow the R40 Phalaborwa.
- 6. Hazyview is about 45km from White River. As you approach Hazyview, there is a T-Junction.
- 7. Turn left at the T-junction following R40. This road will take you to Hazyview Town.
- 8. Carry on straight through the first set of traffic lights.
- 9. In Hazyview Turn right at the second set of traffic lights onto the R536 Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate.

At this point, ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given FROM HAZYVIEW (above)



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RECOMMENDED ROUTE FROM KRUGER MPUMALANGA AIRPORT (KMIA)/(MQP NELSPRUIT): (± 115 KM)

- 1. Turn right from the airport exit onto the R538 and follow the signs to White River (Witrivier).
- **2.** Continue for approximately 12 km, until you reach the first set of traffic lights in White River, with the mosque on your left .
- **3.** Turn right and travel towards Hazyview on the R40. After approximately 45 km, you will go down a steep hill towards a T-junction.
- **4.** Turn left, staying on the R40 which will take you into Hazyview town.
- 5. In Hazyview Turn right at the second set of traffic lights on to the R536 Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate.

At this point ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given FROM HAZYVIEW (above)

RECOMMENDED ROUTE FROM HOEDSPRUIT: (± 165 KM)

- 1. Follow the R40 Klaserie road towards Hazyview / White River.
- 2. Pass through towns Acornhoek, Casteel and Bushbuckridge to get to Hazyview.
- *3.* In Hazyview Turn left at the second set of traffic lights onto the R536 Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate.

At this point, ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given FROM HAZYVIEW (above)

RECOMMENDED ROUTE(S) FROM KRUGER NATIONAL PARK:

Depending on your location in the Kruger National Park, we suggest the following:

ROUTE FROM ORPEN GATE: (± 172 KM)

- ** You can only access Inyati via the **NEWINGTON GATE****
- 1. Follow the R531 from Orpen gate towards the R40.
- 2. At the T-junction, turn left onto the R40 towards Hazyview / White River
- 3. Pass through towns Acornhoek, Casteel and Bushbuckridge to get to Hazyview.
- 4. In Hazyview Turn left at the second set of traffic lights onto the R536 Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate

*At this point, ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given **FROM HAZYVIEW** (above)*

ROUTE FROM PAUL KRUGER GATE, KRUGER NATIONAL PARK / SKUKUZA (SZK) : (± 39 KM)

1. From Skukuza, drive to the Paul Kruger Gate.

SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL PARKS TARIFFS: 1 Nov 2024 to 31 Oct 2025

KRUGER PARK conservation fees apply to all arrivals/departures to/from Skukuza Airport. (exit/entrance via Paul Kruger gate) KNP standard conservation fee: **R128 per person / R64 per child & R128 per vehicle**

- 2. Follow the R536 to Hazyview. After approximately 8km, there will be a signpost for Newington Gate, where you must turn right onto a newly tarred road. Follow the road for approximately 8km until you reach a 4-way stop. There is a small, inconspicuous signpost that says Sabi Sand.
- Turn right at the stop onto the dirt road. Follow the dirt road for about 1.8km to where you will have Happy Homes Primary School on the right-hand side. Turn left here and follow the road for 1.5km to Newington Gate.
- 4. Turn left once you have entered **Newington Gate** and follow all signposts to **Inyati.** The speed limit within the reserve is 40km/h.
