



INYATI GAME LODGE: SELF-DRIVE DIRECTIONS

Inyati Game Lodge's precise location may not be accurately represented on Google Maps. To reach our lodge, please use the NEWINGTON GATE entrance, Sabi Sand Nature Reserve.

ESSENTIAL DETAILS FOR ENTERING SABI SAND NATURE RESERVE

- **Entrance Fees:** A per-person fee is required, payable at the gate, ZAR 170.00 per person.
- **Vehicle Fees for Self-Drive Visitors:** An additional vehicle entrance fee applies. Light vehicle R 370.00 per entry & Heavy vehicle R660.00 per entry
- Upon arrival, please provide your details and the name of your destination lodge to the gate guards.
- **IMPORTANT:** Make sure to obtain a QR code from your lodge before exiting the reserve.
- **Gate Hours:** The gates are open from 05:00 to 22:00, though these times may change. These measures help safeguard the reserve's natural habitat and wildlife.

To access Inyati Game Lodge, proceed towards the town of Hazyview.

- Please refrain from using SatNav, GPS devices, or apps, as they may direct you onto rural, unpaved roads that are unsuitable for travel.

DIRECTIONS TO INYATI GAME LODGE FROM HAZYVIEW: (± 66 KM)

1. Once in Hazyview town, at the second set of traffic lights, turn right onto the R536 (Portia Shabangu), heading towards the Paul Kruger Gate.
2. Approximately 35km along this road, look out for signs indicating the Newington Gate / Sabi Sands on the left-hand side of the road. This turn-off is directly opposite the Main Gate Entrance to Elephant Point.
3. Newington Gate is the access gate to the Sabi Sands Reserve, where Inyati Game Lodge is located – please follow these signs.
4. Turn left and follow this tar road for ± 9 km.
5. Please look out for the Newington gate sign on the left-hand side of the road. You will come to a 4-way crossing and turn right onto a gravel road. Please note that there are NO Stop signs. If you miss the 4-way stop and reach the Viva Garage on your right-hand side, you have gone too far; you must turn around and return to the 4-way stop.
6. After about 1.8 km, a small sign will indicate **Newington Gate**. There is also a sign on the right that says Happy Homes. Turn left here.
7. Continue this road to Newington Gate. You will be required to pay an entrance fee at the gate.

Safety Note as You Approach Inyati Game Lodge

- As you near the lodge, remember that you are entering a wilderness area where predators and high-profile game animals roam freely.
- For your safety, do not exit your vehicle under any circumstances until you have arrived securely at the lodge.



RECOMMENDED ROUTE FROM JOHANNESBURG:

Please note that the drive will take approximately 5½ / 6 hours (± 550km)

1. Take the R21 toward Boksburg / East Rand from Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport.
2. Then, take the **N12** towards eMalahleni (Witbank). This road becomes the **N4** toll road to Nelspruit.
3. Follow the N4 highway past Middleburg (Toll Plaza), eMakhazeni (Belfast), and Machadodorp eNtokozweni)(Toll Plaza). Then, follow the Schoemanskloof option on the N4 towards Nelspruit / **Mbombela**.
4. Head east on N4 Nelspruit Northern Bypass. Slight left 270m, then turn right toward R37. Go through one roundabout (1.1 km). Take the first exit onto R37 (800m) at the roundabout.
5. Turn left onto Madiba Street 1.9 km and continue onto Provincial P9/2 Rd/R40; continue to follow the R40.
6. Enter **White River**, along Chief Mgiyeni Khumalo Drive; at the traffic light (Express Stores on your right), turn left onto Theo Kleynhans Street (sign White River Country Estates) green sign - **R40** Hazyview /R538 Numbi Gate and continue to follow R40 Hazyview. At the roundabout, follow the R40 Phalaborwa.
7. Hazyview is about 45km from White River. As you approach Hazyview, there is a T-Junction.
8. Turn left at the T-junction following R40. This road will take you to Hazyview Town.
9. Carry on straight through the first set of traffic lights.
10. In Hazyview - Turn right at the second set of traffic lights onto the R536 - Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate.

At this point, ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given FROM HAZYVIEW (above)





RECOMMENDED ROUTE FROM KRUGER MPUMALANGA AIRPORT (KMIA)/(MQP NELSPRUIT): (± 115 KM)

1. Turn right from the airport exit onto the R538 and follow the signs to White River (Witrievier) . 
2. Continue for approximately 12 km, until you reach the first set of traffic lights in White River, with the mosque on your left .
3. Turn right and travel towards Hazyview on the R40. After approximately 45 km, you will go down a steep hill towards a T-junction.
4. Turn left, staying on the R40 which will take you into Hazyview town.
5. In Hazyview - Turn right at the second set of traffic lights on to the R536 - Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate.

At this point ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given FROM HAZYVIEW (above)

RECOMMENDED ROUTE FROM HOEDSPRUIT: (± 165 KM)

1. Follow the R40 Klaserie road towards Hazyview / White River.
2. Pass through towns Acornhoek, Casteel and Bushbuckridge to get to Hazyview.
3. In Hazyview - Turn left at the second set of traffic lights onto the R536 - Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate.

At this point, ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given FROM HAZYVIEW (above)

RECOMMENDED ROUTE(S) FROM KRUGER NATIONAL PARK:

Depending on your location in the Kruger National Park, we suggest the following:

ROUTE FROM ORPEN GATE: (± 172 KM)

*** You can only access Inyati via the NEWINGTON GATE***

1. Follow the R531 from Orpen gate towards the R40.
2. At the T-junction, turn left onto the R40 towards Hazyview / White River
3. Pass through towns Acornhoek, Casteel and Bushbuckridge to get to Hazyview.
4. In Hazyview - Turn left at the second set of traffic lights onto the R536 - Portia Shabangu Drive towards the Paul Kruger gate

At this point, ignore your GPS/SatNav instructions and follow the instructions given FROM HAZYVIEW (above)

ROUTE FROM PAUL KRUGER GATE, KRUGER NATIONAL PARK / SKUKUZA (SZK) : (± 39 KM)

1. From Skukuza, drive to the Paul Kruger Gate. 

KRUGER PARK conservation fees apply to all arrivals/departures to/from Skukuza Airport. (exit/entrance via Paul Kruger gate) KNP standard conservation fee.

2. Follow the R536 to Hazyview. After approximately 8km, there will be a signpost for Newington Gate, where you must turn right onto a newly tarred road. Follow the road for approximately 8km until you reach a 4-way stop. There is a small, inconspicuous signpost reading '**Sabi Sand**'.
3. Turn right at the stop onto the dirt road. Follow the dirt road for about 1.8km to where you will have Happy Homes Primary School on the right-hand side. Turn left here and follow the road for 1.5km to Newington Gate.
4. Turn left once you have entered **Newington Gate** and follow all signposts to **Inyati**. The speed limit within the reserve is 40km/h.
